POLICY RELATING TO EDUCATION

PSYCHOLOGICAL SERVICES

The Wachusett Regional School Committee is committed to provide comprehensive psychological services, upon parent/legal guardian approval, mandated by state and federal regulations. Service shall be non-discriminatory and equitable and shall enhance the academic welfare of students. Services shall include student assessment, counseling, consultation, staff development, parent education, crisis intervention, liaison with other providers, and research.

Service Elements:

The following shall be provided as appropriate:

- 1. Individual evaluations of students referred for special education services
- 2. Adherence to due process regulations and confidentiality requirements
- 3. Adherence to non-discriminatory practices in test instrument selection and administration
- 4. Consultation with teacher, parents/legal guardian, and personnel concerning the instruction and/or mental health of students.
- 5. Individual and group counseling
- 6. Direct interventions with students
- 7. Mental health activities, and referral to and/or consultation with outside service agencies
- 8. Staff development and parent education
- 9. Analysis of research findings as it applies to every day practices of the District.

Goals and performance objectives shall be established. Assessment, evaluation, and corrective actions shall be implemented on an annual basis.
